Bullying Prevention Month presentation:

(Presented by Rachel Stair and Jennifer Batchelder)

- MPS Cares is on all students' chrome books. Students can access to report
 any concern or situations in which the student needs support and/or feels
 bullied. The messages go to administrators, guidance, social worker, and
 school psychologist. This has been used by many students and is working
 successfully.
- A "Buddy Bench" has been added to WMS. It has been utilized by students. It was discussed to have the origin of the Buddy Bench be shared with students during Advisory period.
- WMS promotes Kindness. WMS uses a program from Sandy Hook called "Start with Hello." Encouraging students to connect with each other via board games, conversations, positive notes in various school locations, etc.
- Cyber bullying-Provided 3 handouts including conversation starters, digital awareness, and digital monitoring. Parents need to check their children's social media, text messaging, etc. This is vitally important. Parents should know their children's passwords.
- Students complete "Climate Surveys" twice per year. "Student Voices" is another opportunity where students can express their concerns.
- They discussed "Is It Bullying?" flyer and the differences between bullying, a conflict with another student, or a student being mean in one instant.
- Main bulletin board at WMS with positive quotes to encourage positivity and kindness. It is changed throughout the year and displays positive messages and themes.
- Discussed restorative practices. A restorative practice newsletter is sent 4x/year to staff. Ms. Showerda will have that shared with parents as well.

Career Lunch Meetings: Ms. Stair is looking for parents who are willing to come in and talk about their careers. Dates will be 3 days in January. Any grade level students can sign up to attend.
